

## Adding Transitions to Narrative Structure

- To show that passage of time you can add transition.
- The amount of time that passes can be long like years or a few minutes.

### Passages of time examples

Transition Words	Transitions with time
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Later</li><li>• After</li><li>• Next</li><li>• Soon</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Later that day</li><li>• After a few minutes</li><li>• Then, (action)</li><li>• The next day</li></ul>

- Think about breaking your beginning to two parts

<b>Beginning Part 1</b>	Establish when your story takes place.
	Describe the main event.

<b>Beginning Part 2</b>	Use a transition show time has passed.
	Describe the main event.

Repeat the same process for the Middle of the Narrative

<b>Middle Part 1</b>	Establish when your story takes place.
	Describe the main event.

<b>Middle Part 2</b>	Use a transition show time has passed.
	Describe the main event.
