Here Are Several Ways to Implement This Activity in the Classroom:

- To use this worksheet in the classroom, you could post the prompts around the room, with one prompt per station. Then, have students move around the room and talk to their classmates about their responses to each prompt.
 - For example, at the "favorite food" station, students might discuss their favorite foods and why they enjoy them.
 - At the "something you're proud of" station, students might share a recent accomplishment or something they've done that makes them feel proud.
- You could also have students take turns sharing their responses with the group, or you could divide the class into small groups and have them discuss their answers with each other.
- You could also have students draw or create a collage to represent their responses. For example, if someone's favorite hobby is playing soccer, they could draw a picture of themselves playing soccer or create a Slides presentation featuring images of soccer balls, soccer players, and other related items.
